

Exemption List - Part II. University of Melbourne

Timing of Information: [Following Completion of 300-410, Semester 2, 2010](#)

Students whose Student Number appears in the "EXEMPT" column on this list will be recommended for exemption from IAAust Part II. Appropriate application needs to be made, by the student, via Centre for Actuarial Studies, to the Institute of Actuaries of Australia. Requirements for obtaining a recommendation for exemption include adequate performance in examinations and completion of all Compulsory Assignments (as signified by the timely submission of all required student declarations). Decisions regarding exemptions are final.

Students whose Student Number does NOT appear in the EXEMPT column have not achieved the required standard. For purposes of student feedback, the following information is provided for non exempt students:

1. Exemption Carry-forward marks from the exam, for exemption purposes, are provided. The Carry-forward marks are relative to the exemption cut-off level for the exam. For example 4 would indicate that exam mark achieved is four above the exemption cut-off standard. -3 would indicate the exam mark is three below the exemption cut-off standard.
2. Exemption requires the sum of Best_S1 (From 300-410) and Best_S2 (From 300-411). Carry-forward marks be POSITIVE as exemption calculated across both semesters. For example a student who gained carry-forward marks of -4 for their best semester 1 sitting and 5 for their best semester 2 sitting would be recommended for an exemption, as aggregated carry-forward is positive.
3. From our information, a mark of -100 indicates that student has not yet attempted the relevant subject

In some cases, some exemption are made on completion of 300-410 (for students already completed 300-411). This list will be updated as required.

Note: Distance students may need to provide further information if they have previously completed relevant subjects under different student numbers or at other institutions.
